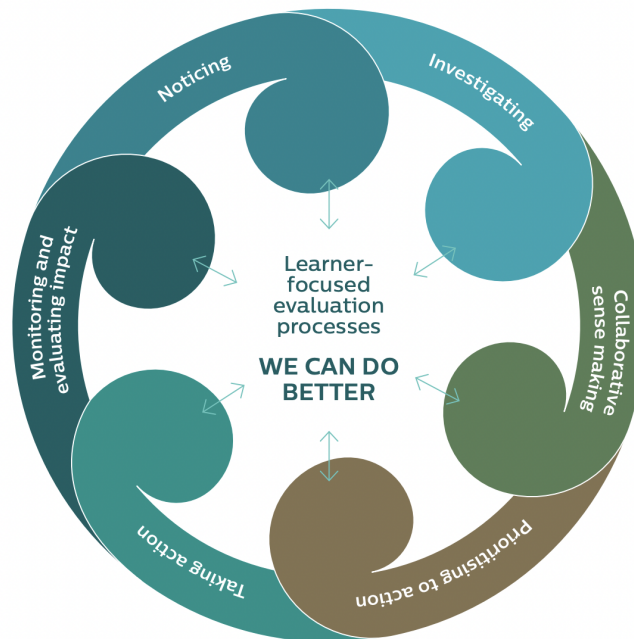

Evaluation Process

Once an area is selected for evaluation, the principal will need to define the terms of reference and to appoint an individual, a panel, or a committee to coordinate the review.

Terms of reference may include:

The scope of the evaluation; strategic or operational, major or minor?

The objectives of the evaluation;

Who will be included; staff, the board, community representatives, student representatives?

How results will be documented and communicated;

Time frames for gathering information, analysing results and communicating findings.
